PFC Roy Lee Jones, III "SCOOBY" was born in Houston, Texas to the late Mr. Roy Lee Jones, Jr. and Mrs. Nanette Yvette William on September 28, 1985, the youngest of five children, two of which preceded him in death. He attended public schools in Houston, and received his GED from Houston Community College.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Lord of the Streets Episcopal Church in May, 1997, Houston, Texas.

Scooby had an interest in music, dance and theatre and performed dance solos at Willowridge High School.

Scooby entered into the Military on March 6, 2006. He completed his basic training in Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, July 27, 2006 (Company C, 787th Military Police Battalion) and transitioned to 984th MP CO in Colorado. He was deployed to Iraq September 7, 2006 where he received several awards, including: the Bronze Star, a Purple Heart, and Good Conduct Medal.

He entered into Eternal rest Thursday, May 10, 2007 in Iraq.

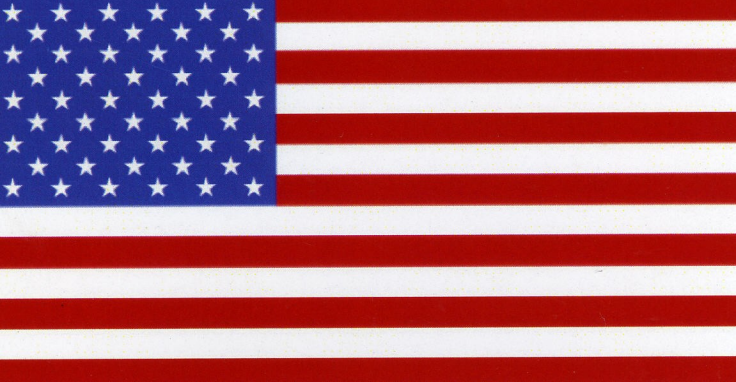
